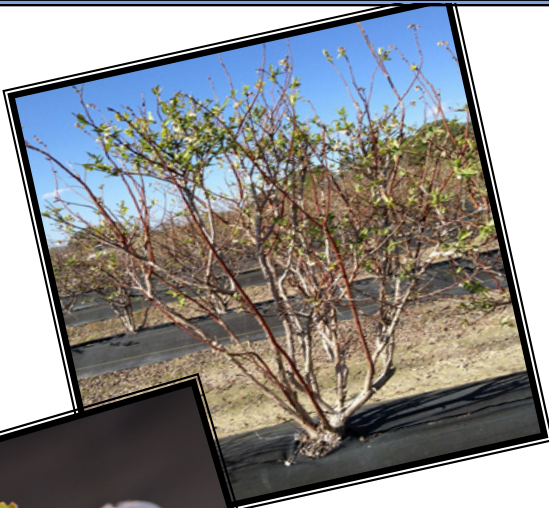


INDIGOCRISP™ 'FL98-325' (U.S. PATENT PENDING)

Southern Highbush Blueberry Cultivar



- ◆ **Estimated Minimum Chill Requirement: 300 Hours**
- ◆ **First Harvest: Around April 15 (Gainesville, FL)**
- ◆ **Growth Habit: Very Upright**
- ◆ **Fruit Size: Large**

Indigocrisp™ 'FL98-325' is an early maturing variety best adapted to areas with chilling requirements similar to or higher than Gainesville, Florida. It produces berries with very firm, crisp-textured skin, and a very high sugar-to-acid ratio. When compared to other crisp-textured cultivars, it matured earlier and has higher yields. Fruit may be mechanically harvested with less damage than traditional berries, and it had the highest packout percentages (94%) after machine harvest in field tests. Fruit received very high scores in consumer taste tests, when compared to industry standards.
